

The Issue:

2.5 million Canadian children live in a household experiencing food insecurity.



President's Choice Children's Charity is removing hunger as a barrier to education for Canadian children.

What We Know:

- · Food insecurity is more prevalent among households with children.
- One in four children under 18 in the ten provinces live in a food-insecure household.+
- In 2024, 2.5 million children under the age of 18 lived in food insecure houses.+
- Well-fed kids perform better at school.
- · 27% higher levels of anxiety are experienced by hungry children.*
- 44.2 % of students eat more fruits and vegetables when schools have gardens.*
- 50 hours of nutrition education are needed to affect behavior change.*

Our goal:

Reach 1 million children annually with good food, and inspire them to make more diverse food choices.



What Will Bring About Change:

- Provide good food, wherever kids are learning.
- · Teach kids how to grow and cook good
- Invest in innovative food systems.
