1 million Canadian children live in a household experiencing food insecurity.



President's Choice Children's Charity is removing hunger as a barrier to education for Canadian children.

What We Know:

- Food insecurity is more prevalent among households with children.
- Well-fed kids perform better at school.
- 27% higher levels of anxiety are experienced by hungry children*
- 44.2 % of students eat more fruits and vegetables when schools have gardens*
- 50 hours of nutrition education are needed to affect behavior change*

Mission: Reach 1 million children annually with good food, and inspire them to make more diverse food choices.

- Teach kids how to grow and cook good food.
